Dear Principal, Head of Life Sciences and Head of Geography,

In our continuous effort of offering new programmes to various grades, below is information regarding our grade 11 course.

Please can you advertise this to your **Grade 11 students** via your Life Sciences and Geography department.

Dates of course: 12th December to 16th December 2022

Venue: Two Oceans Aquarium

Cost: free

The purpose of this course is to:

- provide important basic Oceanographic content
- supplement and support school curriculum material
- provide enrichment for students interested in Ocean Science
- provide an increased interest in Marine careers

Examples of course content include:

- o Ocean chemistry e.g. pH, salinity, density and how this influences Climate science
- o Currents, Tides and Ocean circulation
- Coastal landforms and Sea floor topography
- Diving Physics

The course is being offered to **50 Grade 11 students** who show an interest in marine sciences and who may wish to pursue a career in marine science.

The course is completely sponsored by De Beers Marine.

Applicants will be selected on merit and the strength of their motivation letter, as well as criteria stipulated by the sponsors. Students will be notified whether they have been accepted to the course.

To apply as a sponsored student, students need to:

- Be in **Grade 11** in 2022.
- Write a letter of motivation (about 350 to 500 words) asking to participate. In this letter students should illustrate how they have come to be interested in marine-related topics, and how they feel this course will benefit them. They can also express their future career interests and leadership aspirations. Candidates will be selected mainly on the strength of this motivation, so it is imperative to put time and thought into its compilation.
- Submit the attached letter of application, fully completed.
- Attach a copy of their July/ August 2022 school report
- Provide their own transport to and from the aquarium for the duration of the course.
