
# MPA Day 1 AUGUST 2021 Photo Competition

# **CATEGORIES**

## 1. Scenery

Submit your photos of beautiful sunrises, sunsets, and other scenic shots. These can be above or below the water.

#### 2. Creatures

Submit your photos of marine and estuary wildlife large and small above or below the water.

#### 3. Activities

Submit your photos of friends and family enjoying activities in MPAs – hiking, surfing, diving, snorkelling, kayaking etc. (please have their permission).

# **HOW TO ENTER**

#### **SUBMIT PHOTOGRAPHS HERE**

- Photo size: limited to a max of 3MB and size of 1920 x 1080 pixels.
- Entries: 3 photos per category per photographer (i.e. max submission is 9 photos in total per photographer).
- All images MUST be named with the photographers name, category and MPA name, e.g. JohnDoeCreature1DehoopMPA.
- If you would like us to tag you on Instagram if we share your photo there, please include your Instagram handle as well e.g. @JohnDoe.

- 3. We will assume that, in submitting a photo, you are the owner of the photo and have the right to publish it (including permission/model release for anyone identifiably pictured).
- 4. By submitting a photo, you are giving us permission to use the photo for MPA awareness purposes. We will provide credit to photographers whenever we use any of the photos. These photos are not for sale.
- 5. Submitted photos without information on the photographer, category or location will not be considered.
- 6. No watermarks or copyright text on submitted photos.
- 7. Image size is limited to a maximum of 3MB and the size should be 1920 x 1080 pixels.
- 8. Only 3 entries per category (9 photos in total per photographer).
- 9. Only one form per person needs to be submitted for all entries. If you cannot submit via the form, please send all information and photos to <a href="mailto:mpadaysa@gmail.com">mpadaysa@gmail.com</a>
- 10. The competition opens Fri 9 July and closes on Monday 26th July 2021.
- 11. Winners will be notified telephonically by Friday 30 July 2021.
- 12. Winning photographs will be published on MPA Day on Sunday 1 August 2021 on our Marine Protected Areas social media platforms. **Facebook, Twitter, Instagram**
- 13. Images may be used in educational resources produced to celebrate MPA Day.
- 14. Photos will be judged by MPA Alliance partners.
- 15. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 16. Entry into the competition and acceptance of any prize shall constitute consent on the winner's part to allow the use of the photographer's name and image by the members of the MPA Day Alliance for editorial, advertising, promotional, marketing and/or other purposes without further compensation except where prohibited by law.
